## High Streamflow Advisory for Mountain Headwaters

A **High Streamflow Advisory** has been issued for the following stream and its tributaries in the North Saskatchewan River basin:

- **North Saskatchewan River** upstream of Lake Abraham

This river is responding to the snowmelt caused by this weeks above normal temperatures. River levels are expected to continue to rise for the next few days. However, the rate of rise is expected to slow as temperatures cool over the weekend.

## High Streamflow Advisory Update for Northern Alberta

A **High Streamflow Advisory** remains in effect for the following streams and their tributaries in northern Alberta:

In the **Peace River** basin

- **All tributaries of the Peace River excluding the main stem of the Peace River**, including Smoky River, Notikewin River, Keg River, Wabasca River, Lafond Creek

These rivers levels are slowly receding but remain high.

In the **Hay River** basin

- **Hay River**, including
- **Sousa Creek**
- **Chinchaga River**

The Hay River and the Steen River, a tributary of the Hay River, continue to respond to the precipitation that has fallen over the last week.

Alberta Environment is monitoring river levels closely and is in close contact with Alberta Forestry's and Environment Canada's Weather Services. **A High Streamflow Advisory means that stream levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly and no major flooding is expected.** Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible. Anyone situated close to the streams affected (campers, fishermen, boaters and the general public) is advised to be cautious of the rising levels.

---

**A Flood Watch means that stream levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bank full.** Flooding of areas adjacent to these streams may occur. Anyone situated close to the streams is advised to take appropriate precautionary measures.

---

**A Flood Warning means that rising river levels will result in flooding of areas adjacent to the streams affected.** Anyone situated close to the river should take appropriate measures to avoid flood damage
